### Workshop Description

The course is a paediatric first aid course and meets the requirements of the Early Years foundation stage statutory framework.

The course focuses on emergency scenarios that are faced by professionals, including teachers, au pairs and playgroup leaders looking after young children.

It meets Ofsted requirements for registered childminders and the requirements for nannies under the Dfes Approved Carers Scheme.

The course covers how to deal with accidents and emergencies involving young Children.
